Overnight Parking Exemption

GENERAL INFORMATION

DO NOT SUBMIT WITH APPLICATION

Overnight Parking Permits:

- 1. Annual Overnight Parking Permits are available through the Police Department.
- 2. Each permit issued is to a specific vehicle/household and issued to the registered owner of said vehicle.
- 3. <u>Issued to Bloomingdale Residents Only.</u>

Cost of Overnight Parking Permits

- 1. The cost for overnight parking permit: \$120.00 per year **PER VEHICLE/HOUSEHOLD** and must be renewed annually.
 - APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS MAY BE PURCHASED AT THE BLOOMINGDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS (MONDAY-FRIDAY, 8 AM 4 PM)
- 2. Money orders or checks will be accepted at the Bloomingdale Police Department.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: BOROUGH OF BLOOMINGDALE. RECEIPTS AVAILABLE.

Duration

1. Permit duration is valid for **5 months (November-April)** and is vehicle/household specific.

Denials

- 1. Inability of emergency vehicles to safely pass on roadways will be an immediate denial for permit.
- Trucks over 4 tons, limousines, motor buses, motor delivery wagons, trailers, semitrailers, camping trailers, motor homes, mobile homes and tractors are not eligible for overnight parking permits.

BOROUGH CODE PARKING RESTRICTIONS

7-14 PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified any day upon any of the streets or parts of streets described.

Name of Street Side Hours

All Streets Both Between 12 midnight and sunrise

Between November 1 and April 1

7-8 PARKING PROHIBITED DURING STATE OF EMERGENCY

a. Upon the declaration of an emergency, there shall be no parking upon streets or sections of streets where temporary EMERGENCY NO PARKING signs are displayed. The Chief of Police, or, in his/her absence, the ranking Police Officer is authorized to declare an emergency and to direct the posting of EMERGENCY NO PARKING signs when weather conditions, accidents, road construction, fire or public celebrations dictate or require avoidance of hazards or other conditions which interfere with the free flow of traffic. Notification that EMERGENCY NO PARKING signs are being or will be posted shall be given to the operator or owner of any vehicle which has been parked prior to the posting of the signs.

7-9 TEMPORARY PARKING PROHIBITED FOR SNOW PLOWING AND REMOVAL

- a. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets or highways, an emergency shall exist and no vehicle shall be parked on the streets or highways or portions thereof indicated.
 - The parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
- b. An unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any Police Officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.
